Priority is given to Osler patients who had a stroke within one year of the referral date</p> <p>Osler does not offer any speech-language outpatient services for children</p> <p>A physician referral is required</p>

We help patients progress towards their pre-accident level of function in their work, activities of daily living, mobility, leisure, and social roles</p> <p><b>Electrical Injury Program</b> - Is Canada's only dedicated electrical injury rehabilitation program, highly skilled interprofessional team work with patients and their families to offer customized comprehensive assessment and care to people who have been living with the adverse, often invisible, effects of electrical injuries  Physician referral required. Outpatient referrals are welcome from physicians, rehabilitation consultants and WSIB case managers.</p>
