Children with a life-limiting or life-threatening illness are given an opportunity to be engaged and supported while receiving compassionate palliative care * offers a continuum of care from diagnosis, to respite care, through to the dying process at the end of life  Respite Care: weekend respite stay is 48 hours and during peak times respite stays of up to one week  Day programs and other therapeutic programs such as art therapy, hydrotherapy, music therapy, pet therapy, recreation therapy, multi-sensory snoezelen therapy  Children 0-18 years
