Children with a life-limiting or life-threatening illness are given an opportunity to be engaged and supported while receiving compassionate palliative care * offers a continuum of care from diagnosis, to respite care, through to the dying process at the end of life</p> <p><b>Respite Care:</b> weekend respite stay is 48 hours and during peak times respite stays of up to one week</p> <p><b>Day programs and other therapeutic programs</b> such as art therapy, hydrotherapy, music therapy, pet therapy, recreation therapy, multi-sensory snoezelen therapy</p> <p>Children 0-18 years</p>
