Caledon Community Services Transitional Care Centre Pinnacle View (Supportive Housing Building) 9 McClellan Road, Unit 105 Alton, ON L7K 2N7 905-584-2300 ext. 225 www.ccs4u.org/transitionalcarecentre.aspx	1 single room and 1 double room (3 beds)	The centre operates year round and serves individuals who are medically stable but require additional support in one of the following circumstances: • discharge from hospital and/or post-operative support • short stay respite support/caregiver relief • waiting for Long Term Care Placement (LTC) through the Wait at Home Program Personal Support Workers (PSWs) provide individuals with assistance and support with activities of daily living such as: bathing, dressing, medication, meals and rehabilitation plans. Length of stay and fees: Individuals can stay at TCC between 7-30 days: those admitted in the Wait at Home Program can stay at TCC for duration of the program which is 50 days. Service at TCC cost \$45 per night. Individuals are billed for minimum of 7 days at admission and then gain at the beginning of each week for duration of their stay. Laundry services are extra and are billed at \$4 per load Application: Individuals seeking admission to the Transitional Care Centre can contact Caledon Community Services directly at 905-584-2300 ext. 225

Caledon Community Services (Contd) Transitional Care Centre		Client Eligibility Criteria: • Be 55 years of age or older • Have a permanent residence in the Central West Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) • Be able to transfer (move) with minimal assistance from one Personal Support Worker • Be able to use the washroom independently: the washroom is not wheelchair accessible • Be medically stable; all acute health care needs must be met prior to admission • Be able to remain in the TCC safely and be unsupervised for short periods of time; individuals who wander will not be admitted • Be free of communicable diseases including, but not limited to; MRSA or C-Diff • Have a realistic and attainable care plan with a discharge destination and date • Be able to direct their care Have a support person who is available to transport them to appointments; deliver medications and personal belongings etc. while they are at the TCC

Program provides: • transitional support and rehabilitation for a period of up to 21 days • with a pre-entrance consultation we can provide support with personal care and mobility needs in order to help regain your independence so you may better manage once you return home • Also offer the convenience of a Guest Suite for friends and family who are visiting from out of town. Overnight visits provided on a scheduled basis • Clients who come to stay are transitioning out of the hospital, are waiting in the community for a Long Term Care Bed or are community clients requiring short term personal care supports • The accommodation is not a locked-in unit • Priority given to Individuals residing in the Central West LHIN Eligible tenants living in Richview residence buildings may be offered other services as an alternate to the transitional bed • assisted living/supportive housing for personal care services • congregate dining Eligible tenants living in Widdicombe Hill/Blvd buildings may be offered other services as an alternate to the transitional bed • assisted living/supportive housing for personal care services Fees: \$35 per day includes accommodation, meals, and PSW supports Application: Information and intake by telephone is available Mon-Fri 9:30am-4:30pm.
