Service at TCC cost \$45 per night. Individuals are billed for minimum of 7 days at admission and then gain at the beginning of each week for duration of their stay. Caledon Community Services (Contd) Transitional Care Centre		Client Eligibility Criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be 55 years of age or older • Have a permanent residence in the Central West Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) • Be able to transfer (move) with minimal assistance from one Personal Support Worker • Be able to use the washroom independently: the washroom is not wheelchair accessible • Be medically stable; all acute health care needs must be met prior to admission • Be able to remain in the TCC safely and be unsupervised for short periods of time; individuals who wander will not be admitted • Be free of communicable diseases including, but not limited to; MRSA or C-Diff • Have a realistic and attainable care plan with a discharge destination and date • Be able to direct their care <p>Have a support person who is available to transport them to appointments; deliver medications and personal belongings etc. while they are at the TCC</p>
