City	<u>Service</u>
<b>Snow Removal Financial</b>	City Council has authorized a Financial Assistance Program to help senior citizens and physically challenged
Assistance - Brampton	homeowners with costs incurred from hiring a service provider to remove snow from their sidewalks and driveways.
Call: 311 or	Qualifying applicants can receive a grant of up to \$200 for non-corner lot properties or up to \$300 for corner lot properties with sidewalks on two sides of the property and where both sidewalks are not cleared by City forces
905-874-2000	Eligibility criteria:
	Be 65 or older or be permanently disabled (restrict physical mobility)
	Own and occupy the property on which the application is made
	<ul> <li>Not to have claimed a credit on any other property for the same winter season</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Not live in condominium dwelling where snow removal is the direct responsibility of the condominium corporation</li> </ul>
	Return the application during the winter season, but no later than <b>April 30, 2018</b>
	Snow Removal Financial Assistance Application
	Once the City has approved an application, use the reimbursement form to provide proof of service to the City of Brampton. Requests for rebates must be received by <b>July 31, 2018</b> : Reimbursement Form

Mississauga Yard  Maintenance Subsidy	Low income Senior (65 or older), or a low income physically disabled person may be eligible to receive a financial subsidy of up to \$200 to offset the cost of snow cleaning and grass cutting services.
<u>Application</u>	This subsidy program is restricted to:
Call: 311 or	Low income seniors (65 or older) who are in receipt of GIS
905-615-4311	<ul> <li>Low income physically disabled persons who are in receipt of ODSP</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>A Mississauga resident who resides as owner or legal tenant in the residential property for which the yard maintenance subsidy is required.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Must provide an original invoice or official receipts for a grass cutting /or snow cleaning services within this subsidy year</li> </ul>
	Return the application during the winter season, but no later than April 30, 2018
