Must declare a financial, physical or emotional need for service</p> <p>Volunteer driver provided program - provide return trips for patients from their home to treatment centres. New patients who register for volunteer driver provided transportation will be required to pay a one-time registration fee of \$100. Patients 18 years or younger or are covered by the Northern Health Travel Grant are exempt.
